Life Skills Training (LST) is an evidence-based drug prevention program that incorporates interactive learning, social skills building, and specific drug use prevention-related information in order to provide adolescents and young teens with the confidence and skills necessary to successfully handle challenging situations.

A virtual learning guide has been created enabling SAFE's Social Worker and LST Facilitator Francesca Carbone and her students the ability to continue where they left off in the program. Instruction via Zoom has allowed the Youth Bureau and SAFE to combine the use of technology and remote learning to successfully deliver necessary prevention education.

According to Spiro Tsirkas, Youth Bureau's Executive Director: "This hard time for everyone, it's very important for our youth to experience some familiarity and some normalcy. SAFE and the Youth Bureau will continue to work together to provide virtual Life Skills Training weekly. The students will receive important information while having the opportunity to see Ms. Carbone".
